

Kadima 2020-2021 Youth Merit Scholarship Program

The Jacksonville Jewish Center's Setzer Youth Education Department seeks to reward exemplary participants with financial assistance to **further** engage in programs offered through USY, Ramah, and USCJ sponsored programs.

Youth Merit Scholarships are awarded based on participation in the Center's community by demonstrating an engagement and dedication to the following components:

- □ Service Volunteering at the Center
- Study Participation in a Galinsky Academy School or JTLI
- **Prayer** Attending shabbat and holiday services
- **Engagement** Participation in Kadima Activities
- Leadership Taking the initiative with others

Scholarship dollars are available for middle and high school students attending **Sub-Regional, Regional, and International United Synagogue Youth** sanctioned events, as well as approved Jewish summer camps and programs.*

These events and programs provide experiences with Jewish peers outside of the synagogue that enhance the Jewish value and education provided by the Jacksonville Jewish Center. The Youth Merit Scholarship Program begins on Sunday, September 6, 2020.

TO APPLY for Youth Merit Scholarships

- 1. Speak with Sara Crowe.
- Make a short video saying "Shalom! My name is... and I love JJ(Sea) Turtles because... and I want to apply for this program because..."
- 3. Complete the minimum requirements outlined on the front of this page. Requirements are cumulative.
- 4. Videos for year round scholarship must be submitted by Wednesday, October 14th, 2020.
- 5. Declaration of Intent for Summer Scholarship must be made by January 8th, 2021. There is a mandatory meeting for applicants on December 8th, 2020.

Eligibility requirements include students whose families are members in good standing with the Jacksonville Jewish Center, current with payments of the Galinsky Academy school tuition, Youth Group dues and completion of the Setzer Youth Education online registration form found at <u>jaxjewishcenter.org/syeregistration</u>.
